

## UK Broadband Speedtest Results March 2011

This press release gives the aggregated speedtest results from tests carried out by site users at [www.broadband.co.uk](http://www.broadband.co.uk) for March 2011.

Virgin Media yet again extend their average speeds to hot 13.481Mbps. Eclipse manage to improve on their average by a good margin and hold the second spot, O2/Be gain slightly from the previous month to hold third place with BT becoming only the fourth provider to post a monthly average over 5Mbps.

Overall the average of all suppliers breaks the 7Mbps barrier for the first time.

Our average speed by time of day shows how the average broadband speed is heavily influenced by the time of day (and therefore likely level of network congestion).

The overnight levels show a significantly higher average speed than the evening peak period. This clearly shows the effects of network congestion on the average broadband connection at peak hours.
